Negro Leaguers and the Hall of Fame Steven R. Greenes, 2020-09-15 Since 1971, 35 Negro League baseball players and executives have been admitted to the Hall of Fame. The Negro League Hall of Fame admissions process, which has now been conducted in four phases over a 50-year period, can be characterized as idiosyncratic at best. Drawing on baseball analytics and surveys of both Negro League historians and veterans, this book presents an historical overview of NLHOF voting with an evaluation of whether the 35 NL players selected were the best choices. Using modern metrics such as Wins Above Replacement (WAR), 24 additional Negro Leaguers are identified who have Hall of Fame qualifications. Brief biographies are included for HOF quality players and executives who have been passed over, along with reasons why they may have been excluded. A proposal is set forth for a consistent and orderly HOF voting process for the Negro Leagues.

context with recent trends and issues in baseball Includes questions and solutions for math practice **For the Good of the Country** David Finoli,2015-09-11 Like virtually every other aspect of American life baseball was affected by World War II Many of its players left the playing field for the battlefield but the game continued played by those who stayed behind Wartime baseball entertained a nation in desperate need of a diversion and a morale boost in a time of crisis This book studies baseball during World War II with both a statistical analysis of the game and stories of its players those who went to war and those who did not It provides recaps for each season between 1942 and 1945 and season by season recaps and highlights for each team Starting lineups of the war years are compared to the starting lineups of 1941 the last year of peacetime baseball to show how dramatically the war changed the game A list of players who went to war is provided along with a list of players who replaced them on the roster if they were starters or starting pitchers Brief statistical sketches of players who went to the war discuss their play before and after and how they were replaced Other lists include wartime players who lost their starting jobs in 1946 minor league players who died in the war and Negro League players who were drafted **Ray Schalk** Brian E. Cooper,2009-10-21 This is the first book length biography of Hall of Fame catcher Ray Schalk once described as the yardstick against which all other catchers were measured For years the top defender at his position Schalk was also a fiery leader on the field and he guided two teams to the World Series One of those teams however was the 1919 Black Sox whose conspiracy to throw the Series left Schalk with a deep and abiding sense of betrayal After he retired as a player the Illinois native spent decades as a manager or coach on the collegiate minor league and major league levels Schalk entered the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1955 **Baseball's All-Time Best Hitters** Michael J. Schell,2013-12-03 Tony Gwynn is the greatest hitter in the history of baseball That s the conclusion of this engaging and provocative analysis of baseball s all time best hitters Michael Schell challenges the traditional list of all time hitters which places Ty Cobb first Gwynn 16th and includes just 8 players whose prime came after 1960 Schell argues that the raw batting averages used as the list s basis should be adjusted to take into account that hitters played in different eras with different rules and in different ballparks He makes those adjustments and produces a new list of the best 100 hitters that will spark debate among baseball fans and statisticians everywhere Schell combines the two qualifications essential for a book like this He is a professional statistician applying his skills to cancer research and he has an encyclopedic knowledge of baseball He has wondered how to rank hitters since he was a boy growing up as a passionate Cincinnati Reds fan Over the years he has analyzed the most important factors including the relative difficulty of hitting in different ballparks the length of hitters careers the talent pool that players are drawn from and changes in the game that raised or lowered major league batting averages the introduction of the designated hitter and changes in the height and location of the pitcher s mound for example Schell s study finally levels the playing field giving new credit to hitters who played in adverse conditions and downgrading others who faced fewer obstacles His final ranking of players differs dramatically from the traditional list Gwynn for example

bumps Cobb to 2nd place Rod Carew rises from 28th to 3rd Babe Ruth drops from 9th to 16th and Willie Mays comes from off the list to rank 13th Schell's list also gives relatively more credit to modern players containing 39 whose best days were after 1960 Using a fun conversational style the book presents a feast of stories and statistics about players ballparks and teams all arranged so that calculations can be skipped by general readers but consulted by statisticians eager to follow Schell's methods or introduce their students to such basic concepts as mean histogram standard deviation p value and regression Baseball's All Time Best Hitters will shake up how baseball fans view the greatest heroes of America's national pastime
