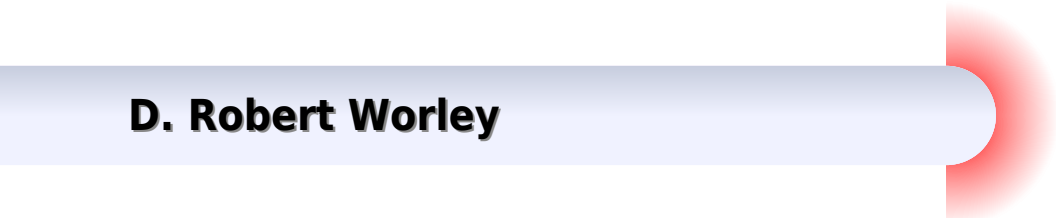

The Theocons Damon Linker, 2007-09-04 An essential history of the influential men who have spearheaded the movement to erode the wall separating church and state Beginning as far left radicals during the 1960s the theocons in Damon Linker's book including Richard John Neuhaus Michael Novak and George Weigel gradually transitioned to conservatism when they grew frustrated with the failures of the decade's revolutionary goals Linker shows how starting during the Reagan administration they worked to forge a Christian alliance between Evangelical Protestants and Conservative Catholics By injecting the language of faith into political life this movement appealed to a wide swath of voters and ultimately played a central role in the election of George W Bush The Theocons is an absorbing and revelatory look at an ideological crusade that every American needs to know about *False Prophets* Richard Bonney, 2008 After 9 11 the US response to Al Qaeda the Global War on Terror was heavily influenced by the clash of civilizations theory This book identifies the twenty first century proponents of the thesis such as Bernard Lewis and Daniel Pipes their links to the Bush government and their roles in exploiting hostility between the West and Islam *America's Right* Robert B. take the world next *The Rise of Common-Sense Conservatism* Antti Lepistö, 2021-04-20 In the years following the election of Donald Trump a victory that hinged on the votes of white Midwesterners who were both geographically and culturally distant from the media's coastal concentrations there has been a flurry of investigation into the politics of the so called common man The notion that the salt of the earth purity implied by this appellation is best understood by conservative politicians is no recent development though As Antti Lepistö shows in his timely and erudite book the intellectual wellsprings of conservative common sense discourse are both older and more transnational than has been thought In considering the luminaries of American neoconservative thought among them Irving Kristol Gertrude Himmelfarb James Q Wilson and Francis Fukuyama Lepistö argues that the centrality of their conception of the common man accounts for the enduring power and influence of their thought Intriguingly Lepistö locates the roots of this conception in the eighteenth century Scottish Enlightenment revealing how leading neoconservatives weaponized the ideas of Adam Smith Thomas Reid and David Hume to denounce postwar liberal elites educational authorities and social reformers Their reconfiguration of Scottish Enlightenment ideas ultimately gave rise to a defining force in modern conservative politics the common sense of the common man Whether twenty first century politicians who invoke the grievances of the people are conscious of this unusual lineage or not Lepistö explains both the persistence of the trope and the complicity of some conservative thinkers with the Trump regime
