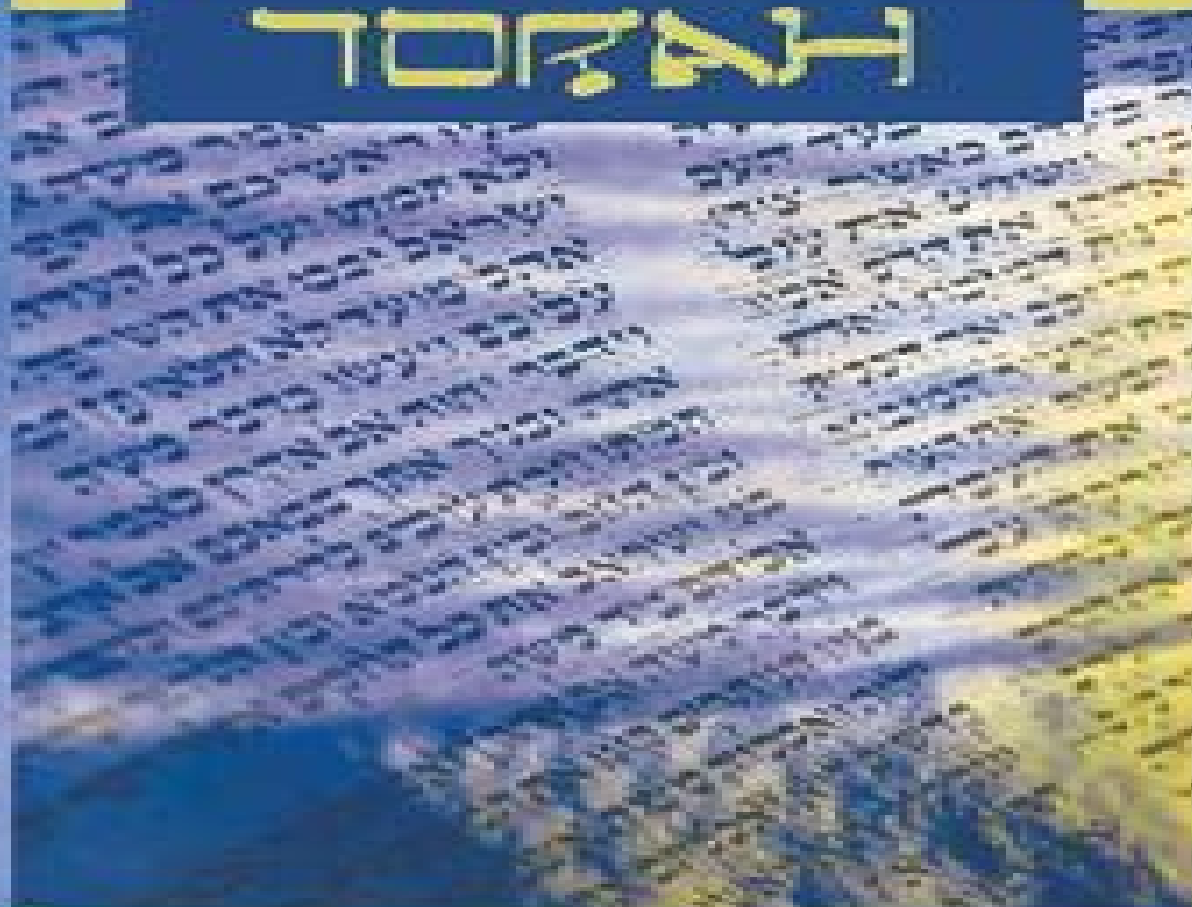

Christian readers understood him instead as a Jewish witness for Christian truths Menasseh's Jewish coreligionists disapproved of what they perceived to be his dangerous involvement in Christian debates providing non Jews with delicate information It was only a century after his death that Menasseh became a model for new generations of Jewish scholars
