Via's book signals a major shift in the study of parables. Via's theory of the parables, what they are and how they work, is different from every theory that preceded him, and his reviewers noted the uniqueness of his approach. Charles W. Hedrick, author of *Many Things in Parables: Jesus and His Modern Critics*, beginning in the 1960s, scholarship on the parables became an American enterprise and has remained such. Robert Funk and Dan Via independently of each other instigated a new approach to the parables that was as revolutionary as Julicher's rejection of allegory.
