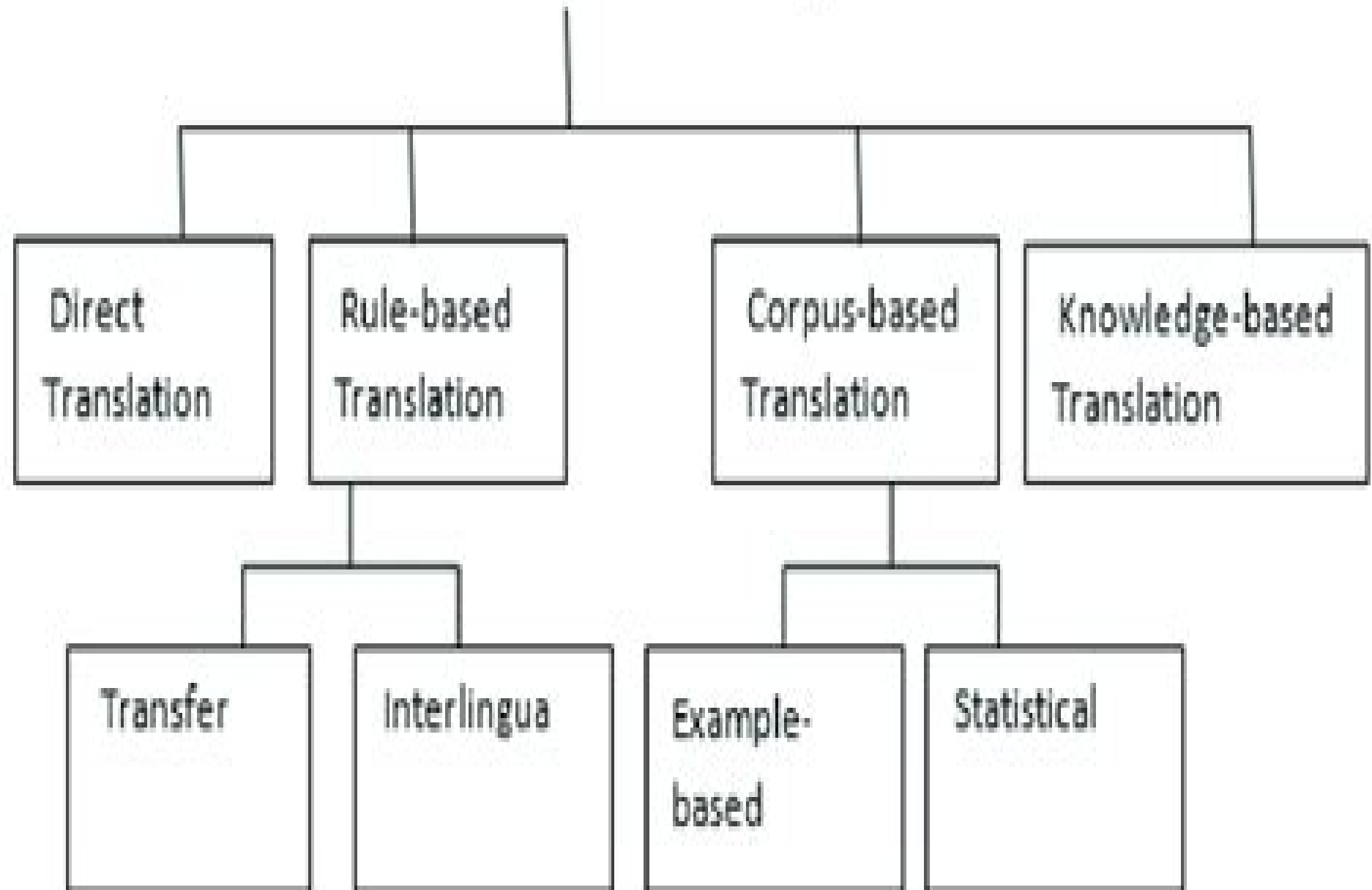

fluency scales The text also looks at error analysis to evaluate the systems output in terms of orthography lexis grammar and semantics at the entire text level and in terms of lexis grammar and semantics at the collocation level The research findings contained within this volume provide important feedback about the capabilities of the three MT systems with respect to EnglishArabic translation and paves the way for further research on such an important topic This book will be of interest to scholars and students of translation studies and translation technology

idiomatic expressions A comparison of METIS II with three commercial systems shows that idioms are not impossible to translate as it was predicted in 1952 The only way for a machine to treat idioms is not to have idioms This book furnishes plenty of examples of idiomatic phrases and provides the foundation for how MT systems can process and translate idioms by means of simple linguistic resources
