The Traumatic Past and Uncertain Future of South Sudan Nhial Thiwat Ruach, 2015-11-25 This book examines post colonial and post independence challenges facing South Sudan both external and internal factors as it transitions into becoming a nation state Other focuses are issues that hinder the implementation of good governance delivery of services to the people preservation of the environment and natural resources and the unity among South Sudans multiple ethnicities The book also briefly touches on my personal journey in pursuit of elementary and higher education a rough journey that began in a country that has been ravaged by a civil war Therefore it would serve as informative and inspirational to those who may face difficult experiences as a refugee or emigrants In addition this book supposed to be published in the summer of 2013 however the author was caught in a civil war that broke out while on a visit in South Sudan and he escaped near death twice in the Juba massacres of the Nuers and the attack on his home town of Ulang all were carried out by the South Sudan military ordered by countrys leader Salva Kiir Mayardit As a result the author was stranded in the remote area of South Sudan for more than a year before he could finally return to the United States Since this book is written from Social Responsibility and Social Justice perspectives it addresses some of the issues that affect individual and the society as whole And some of the Issues covered in this book were among the forecasting challenges and problems that are now facing people of South Sudan under the leadership of Salva Kiir and some of them came to reality as I predicted them during the writings of this book

Child, Adolescent and Family Refugee Mental Health Suzan J. Song, Peter Ventevogel, 2020-06-15 More than half of the 25.9 million refugees in the world are under the age of 18 and the mental health of these children and adolescents constitutes a growing global public health priority Refugee children and their families are at increased risk to develop mental health problems but they often face major challenges in accessing adequate treatment and mental health professionals frequently feel ill equipped to assist this group Refugees are faced with a plethora of issues including the ambiguous loss of loved ones psychological trauma related to past experiences of violence and atrocities the complexities of daily life as a refugee and the challenges to adapt to new systems of care and support Refugees' life circumstances all too often undermine their agency as they face discrimination stigma and social isolation or exclusion Refugees are frequently disconnected from the usual family and community supports that they once had which creates additional mental distress As parents struggle with these changes their children often find it even more difficult to adapt and connect with them This all leads to increased prevalence of mental health conditions among refugees Humanitarian policies recommend family centered interventions that are multi sectoral multi disciplinary and focus on optimizing resource utilization Over the last decade a considerable body of research has emerged around socio ecological

models of mental health family and community approaches and resilience and strengths based theories but these insights are insufficiently incorporated in the practice of mental health care for refugee children Clinicians often struggle to grasp the common unique stressors that families face and are not familiar with working with families as units for intervention Using culturally and contextually informed assessment methods and family oriented management approaches not only help individual children or adolescents but also their families This book aims to provide an overview of the latest theoretical insights from research on sociocultural aspects of mental health and connect these with clinical insights from practical mental health care provision Using strengths based resiliency oriented and family centered approaches can enrich clinical practice in refugee mental health but clinicians need to translate the emerging evidence into concrete steps and interventions This requires additional skills for the assessment and management of mental health conditions in refugee children and families The chapters in this book are written by a diverse group of authors using global multi disciplinary approaches The chapters provide examples from various contexts including refugees who are displaced to neighboring countries refugees on the move and refugees and asylum seekers in resettlement settings This book is therefore a unique resource for clinicians researchers and policy makers working on mental health issues of refugee children and adolescents around the world

Minority and Indigenous Trends 2018: Focus on migration and displacement Peter Grant, Carl Söderbergh, 2018-09-12 Conflict urbanization climate change globalization and a host of other factors are contributing to the current era of mass migration and displacement But while hundreds of millions of people are on the move between different cities countries and continents within this larger process there is also a distinct minority and indigenous experience that can shape every step of the journey Indeed though the specific role that identity can play is not always recognized for many communities this may be at the heart of their decision to migrate Understanding migration from a minority and indigenous rights perspective provides an important lens to assess the dynamics of different stages of the journey the exclusion and persecution that can drive the initial decision to migrate the ways that discrimination can profoundly shape the experiences of migrants in transit and the continued presence of ethnic or religious prejudice even for those fortunate enough to reach their intended destination But while all too often migration may only replicate the cycle of exclusion it can also offer the possibility of safety and better opportunities for marginalized communities This volume explores some of the key forces shaping minority and indigenous migration across the world today with regional case studies illustrating the particular challenges faced by different groups Together they illustrate the importance of a rights based approach to migration prioritizing protection and inclusion including of those belonging to minorities and indigenous peoples instead of containment or deportation
